



The Clubroom Flag

You will notice we now have a flag inside the club rooms, the flag itself is very interesting. Made by Tudor House, a company formed in 1931 that is still in business today. If you look at the flag closely you will see that all the stars are double in that they are stitched from both sides i.e. two stars stitched together. Tudor House had two ladies joined the company when they were in their 20's and retired recently after working all their life at Tudor House so we could find out who made our flag. This flag was bought in 1973 by Liam O'Connor's father, Des O'Connor, to fly on the stern of his 30 ft wooden yacht, "Naarilla". Some years later Naarilla was replaced by a motor cruiser, "Westerly" and the attached photo, taken in about 1988, shows his mother Barbara with Des on Westerly, with the flag fitted to the stern. So interestingly this flag now residing in our clubrooms is as old as the club itself.

The flag adds to the generous donation of the display cabinet at the rear of the clubrooms.
